Online registration and payment (closed on July 5th, 2017)

★ JUSTEC 2017 Registration Fee:

The registration fee for all 4 days (September 14th to September 17th, 2017) includes: presentation/participation in JUSTEC sessions, welcome reception, 2 conference lunches (September 15th & 16th), refreshment during conference, publication of conference abstracts & proceedings, and handouts. For the school visit, you will need to pay a school visit fee (See below).

Notes:

- The registration & payment site will be closed after July 5th, 2017.
- For regular participants, all payment is expected to be completed by July 5th, 2017 (US Hawaii time).
- **All presenting authors must have a paid registration by June 5th, 2017 to ensure inclusion into the program.**
- Dinner on Saturday and Sunday will be on your own.
- Transportation between University of Hawaii at Manoa and your accommodation off-campus will be on your own (Need cash for public bus transportation).
- Participants will make their own hotel reservations directly with a reserved block of rooms available off-campus at the University of Hawaii at Manoa discount rate (Hotel information will come later).

★ **School Visit on September 14th, 2017** (optional, but highly recommended to attend)

We plan to visit Waikiki Elementary school on September 14th as an optional school visit. This school visit is tied into the keynote address on Friday and is a chance to see “philosophy for children” (the subject of the keynote address) in action in the classrooms.

School Visit Fee <u>with</u> transportation (includes bento lunch at the school, hired bus from campus, gift to the school from the JUSTEC participants, and handouts)	\$30
School Visit Fee <u>without</u> transportation (includes bento lunch at the school, gift to the school from the JUSTEC participants and handouts)	\$20
* Walking (25-30 minutes) or public bus (10 minutes) from your Waikiki hotel.	

Note:

- The space for school visit is limited, so first come first serve.
- Please sign up for the school visit when you complete your online registration and payment.
- If you cannot select the school visit on the on-line registration site, please notify the JUSTEC Japan office (justec@tamagawa.ac.jp) to put your name on the waiting list. The JUSTEC office will inform you when there is any availability later. You will be requested to complete your registration and payment within a week after the notification.

★ **Optional Tour on September 17th, 2017**

It will be a visit to the Honolulu Museum of Arts, especially to visit the fine Michener Collection of Ukiyo-e (one of the best outside of Japan). You can sign up for the optional tour when you complete your online registration and payment.

★ **Payment**

- All payment will be done on the JUSTEC payment site. No on-site payment will be accepted.
- The deadline for payment is July 5, 2017 (US Hawaii time) for regular participants (not presenting), but the early bird rate is only available by June 5th, 2017.
- The JUSTEC Office will provide your receipt at the registration desk during the JUSTEC 2017.
- **As mentioned above, all presenting authors must have a paid registration by June 5th, 2017 to ensure inclusion into the program.**

★**Cancellation Policy**

Cancellations made by July 4th, 2017 (US Hawaii time) will be refunded the full cost of the conference. Cancellations made after July 5th, 2017 will not be eligible for refund. Anyone who is registered, but cannot attend may send a substitute.
